Yard Waste Collected Mondays - year round

Bag, Bin, and Bundle!

GRASS CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, BRANCHES, BRUSH, TREE TRIMMINGS & CHRISTMAS TREES.



(paper bag only)

(tie with twine or string)

- Place Yard Waste in same spot as trash cans.
- <u>Paper</u> Bagging is preferred, but if placed in a can, pack it loosely. (Make sure there is no trash in the can. No plastic bags for Yard Waste
- Contents plus the Can must not weigh more than 50 pounds. Please, <u>no wet grass</u>. If the can is too heavy to lift, it will not be collected.
- **Tie branches in bundles:** not longer than 4 feet, not wider than 2 feet, not over 50 pounds in weight, no branches over 1.5 in. round.
- Christmas Trees collected through January can be placed loose at curbside, no paper bagging required.

- Bamboo
- Poison Ivy
- Diseased & Insect-

- Thistle
- Poison Oak
- infested Plant Material

- **Root Balls**
- Poison Sumac
- Soil/Dirt
- Stumps

HOW DO I GET RID OF IT?

Items in BOLD = put out in regular trash for collection.

Soil/Dirt = spread it out in your yard or garden.

Stumps = take to Scarboro Landfill
