

SNOW REMOVAL is a shared challenge.

~ Here are a few Tips to help ease the burden of snow removal this season ~

➡ **We pre-treat the roadways and then,
As the snow falls...**

DPW must begin with the main roads leading to the hospital and fire houses first.

Our snow plow drivers start with making 1 pass through the middle of the roadways to keep a lane open for emergency vehicles.

➡ **As the snowfall tapers off ...**

Our job is to clear all City-owned roadways as quickly as possible - *from curb to curb*.

TIP # 1

It is a good idea to **wait until the plows have cleared your street from curb to curb** before you begin to shovel your driveway and sidewalks.

2

Shovel the snow to the right of your driveway – *away* from the street.

This tip can help you avoid having the snow getting pushed back in by plows.

3

Shovel or throw the snow onto your grass. This helps keep the roadways clear and... it is City Code. [Ch. 190-42]

4

Where possible, and for those with driveways, **please do not park on the street.** Plows have difficulty weaving around vehicles.

5

Please help **clear the fire hydrants and storm drains** near your home. Both cause a hazard when blocked.
