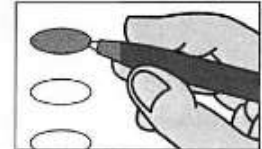

Making Selections

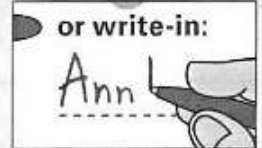


Fill in the oval to the left of the name of your choice. You must blacken the oval completely, and do not make any marks outside of the oval. You do not have to vote in every race.

Ballot Question

The Mayor and City Council of Havre de Grace has declared lots located on Village Drive in Battery Village, sometimes also known as Bradford Green, to be surplus City property which are not needed for public purpose. The surplus land is shown as lots 22, 23 and 24 of Parcel 0020 on Harford County Tax Map No. 605, and are designated as addresses 425, 427 and 429 Village Drive. The land is unimproved real property. The City Council passed Ordinance 1097 on February 21, 2023 authorizing the transfer of ownership of the three properties to Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna, Inc. As consideration for the transfer, Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna, Inc. is to pay any fees incurred as part of the transfer of said properties, including transaction fees, transfer fees and taxes, recording fees and taxes, as may be applicable, and all engineering and surveying costs incurred to construct townhomes on the subject properties. Under the terms of the agreement of transfer, the title to the three properties will be transferred and conveyed by the City "as is" to Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna, Inc. for fulfillment of its charitable purposes and said lots are not to be resold by Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna, Inc. as vacant land.
