CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 297						
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WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 18 A, The Mayor is the Chief Executive Officer of the City of Havre de Grace and has the duty of general supervision of the City, its employees, and its property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 63 of the City Charter, "The Director of Public Works, shall be responsible for fleet management and the yacht basin and marina, and all matters relating to the maintenance and operation of the City physical environments including, but not limited to streets, water, waste water, sanitation, City facilities, related capital assets, construction management, maintenance and operation of the physical properties of the City and other duties as assigned; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council believe it to be in the best interest of the residents of the City of Havre de Grace and in the interest of effective and efficient government to adopt the said amendment to the City Charter to clarify the duties of the Mayor and Director of Public Works under the Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is determined, decided, and resolved by the City Council that the following is hereby approved.

Section 65 of the City Charter is to be amended as follows, with the words underscored to be added and the words in bold and brackets to be deleted.

Section 65 Control of public ways.

The City has control of all public ways in the City, except such as may be under the jurisdiction of the Maryland State Highway Commission. Subject to the laws of the State of Maryland and this Charter the [City] Director of Public Works, under the direction of the Mayor and subject to approved budget expenditures, may establish, operate and maintain in good condition the public ways of the City.

Section 66 of the City Charter is to be amended as follows, with the words underscored to be added and the words in bold and brackets to be deleted.

61 Section 66 Powers of City as to public ways.

The [City] <u>Director of Public Works</u>, <u>under the direction of the Mayor and subject to approved</u> budget expenditures, shall have the power to:

- 66 A. Establish, regulate and change from time to time the grade lines, width, and construction materials of any City public way or part thereof, bridges, curbs and gutters.
- 68 B. Grade, lay out, construct, open, extend, and make new City public ways.
- 69 C. Grade, straighten, widen, alter, improve, or close up any existing City public way or part thereof.
- 71 D. Pave, surface, repave, or resurface any City public way or part thereof.
- 72 E. Install, construct, reconstruct, repair, and maintain curbs and/or gutters along any City public way or part thereof.

- 74 F. Construct, reconstruct, maintain, and repair bridges.
- 75 G. Name City public ways.
- H. Have surveys, plans, specifications, and estimates made for any of the above activities or projects or parts thereof.

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Section 67 of the City Charter is to be amended as follows, with the words underscored to be added and the words in bold and brackets to be deleted.

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82 Section 67 Powers of City as to sidewalks.

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The [City] <u>Director of Public Works</u> <u>under the Direction of the Mayor and subject to approved budget expenditures</u> shall have the power to:

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- 87 A Establish, regulate, and change from time to time the grade lines, width, and construction 88 materials of any sidewalk or part thereof on City property along any public way or part 89 thereof.
- 90 B. Grade, lay out, construct, reconstruct, pave, repair, extend or otherwise alter sidewalks on City property along any public way or part thereof.
- 92 C. Require that the owners of any property abutting on a sidewalk keep the sidewalk clear of all ice, snow, and other obstructions.
- D. Require and order the owner of any property abutting on any public way in the City to perform any projects authorized by this section at the owner's expense according to reasonable plans and specifications. If, after due notice, the owner fails to comply with the order within a reasonable time, the City may do the work, and the expense shall be a lien on the property and shall be collectible in the same manner as are town taxes or by suit at law.

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Section 68 of the City Charter is to be amended as follows, with the words underscored to be added and the words in bold and brackets to be deleted.

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103 Section 68 Water and sewers.

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The [City] <u>Director of Public Works</u>, <u>under the Direction of the Mayor and subject to approved</u> budget expenditures, shall have the power to:

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- 108 A. Construct, operate and maintain a water system and water plant.
- 109 B. Construct, operate and maintain a sanitary sewerage system and a sewage treatment plant.
- 110 C. Construct, operate and maintain a stormwater drainage system and stormwater sewers.
- D. Construct, maintain, reconstruct, enlarge, alter, repair, improve, or dispose of all parts, installations, and structures of the above plants and systems.
- Have surveys, plans, specifications and estimates made for any of the above plants and systems or parts thereof or the extension thereof.
- F. Do all things it deems necessary for the efficient operation and maintenance of the above plants and systems.
