Havre de Grace - a vibrant waterfront city where the Susquehanna River meets the Chesapeake Bay - is seeking motivated **students to join our Habitat Management Internship Program.**

Interns will work directly under the mentorship of the City's Manager of Living Shorelines, Jodie Shivery, gaining hands-on experience managing and restoring approximately 15 acres of high-profile ecological landscape. This is applied conservation in action.

If you're interested in pursuing a career in environmental science, landscape architecture, ecology, conservation, or another green industry, this internship offers real-world field experience that strengthens your resume and your skillset.

What You'll Gain

Interns receive immersive, field-based training in:

- Native plant identification and management
- Urban and natural pollinator habitat management
- Ecologically focused tidal, and MD Critical Area buffer management
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM) strategies
- Invasive species identification, and cultural management
- Identification of poisonous and stinging plants and insects and their practical tolerance

End the summer with practical coastal landscape habitat management skills.

This is an active, outdoor internship experience. Interns can expect:

- Heat, humidity, light rain, and natural terrain. Extreme care will be taken to avoid contact with stinging bees and poisonous plants
 - to lift 25 pounds, perform tasks requiring bending, crawling and standing conditions with the use of hand gardening tools.
